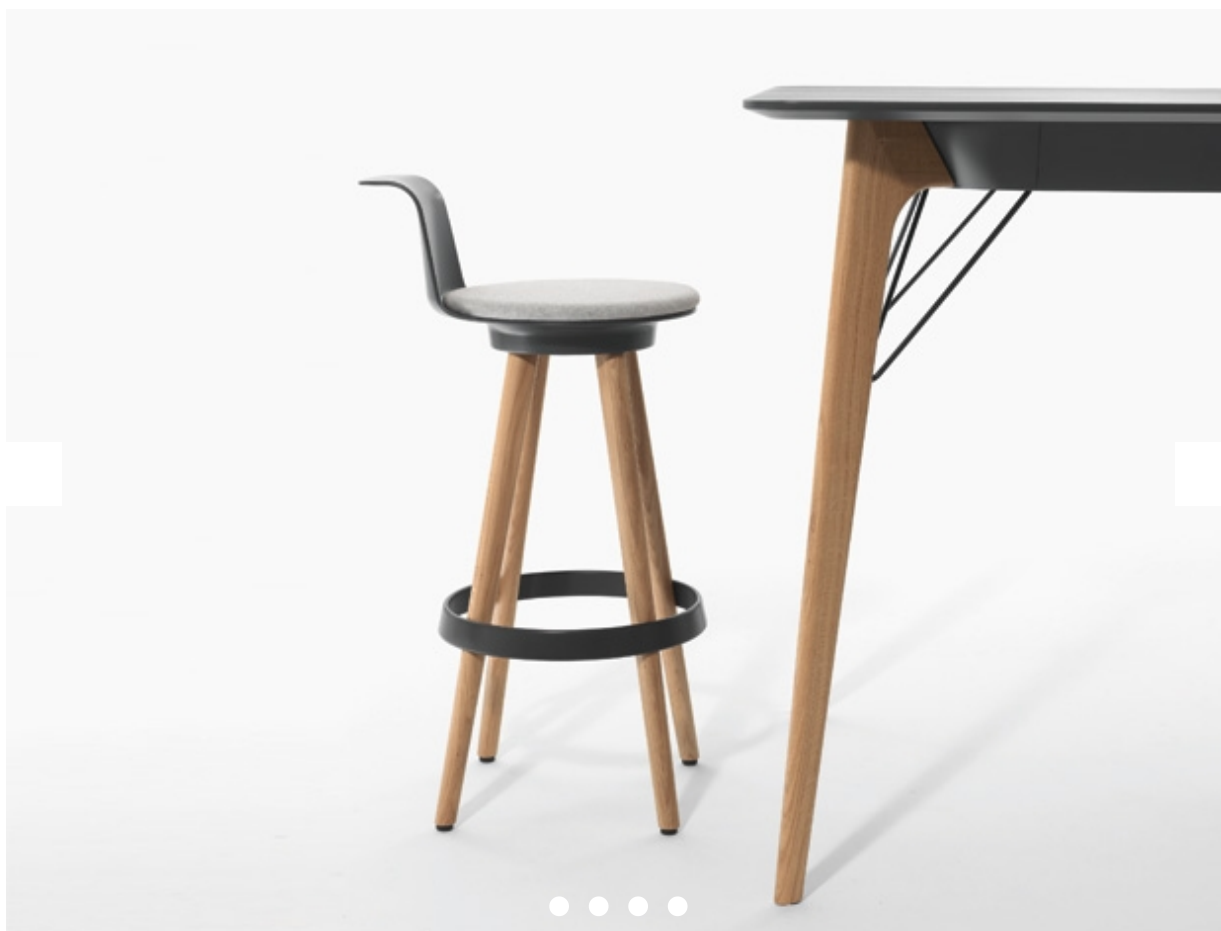

PearsonLloyd and Bene continue their Anglo-Austrian relationship with the launch of the Timba table and stool.

The table's legs are made from solid oak with either a natural finish or stained in graphite, and are connected to a top of formed plywood. A 'turntable' in the centre covers a bowl where the power and network connections are located. The stool has tapered oak legs and a seat shell in moulded plastic in off-white or dark grey, covered in a range of fabrics or leathers.

The Timba range is designed to serve as a hub for the team-based activities that are now the mainstay of the modern office environment.
